One of the saddest deaths that has occurred here for some time was that of Mrs. Paul L. Krueger, who passed away at the local hospital Monday night, at 10:30, following an operation, which was performed Saturday night.

Mrs. Krueger, who had been in poor health for some time, about a month ago had a bad fall and injured herself, and she never recovered from the effects and her condition continued to grow worse.

Mrs. Krueger, whose maiden name was Lorenz, was born at James, S. D., May 3, 1884 and has lived in this vicinity all her life. She was united in marriage to Paul L. Krueger on Oct. 22, 1901. In 1906 they moved into Groton, where they have continued to reside. Eight children, six girls and two boys survive with the sorrowing husband. One child died in infancy. Other near relatives are her mother, Mrs. G. Lorenz, three brothers, W. T., Ben. and Albert Lorenz, two sisters, Mrs. Chas. Gengerke and Mrs. Frank Jensen, her grandmother and other relatives.

The passing of this faithful wife, devoted mother, loving sister and daughter, a true friend and neighbor and a loyal Christian is a source of deep sorrow.

Deceased was a life long member of the Lutheran church.

Funeral services will be held this (Thursday) afternoon, at 1:00 o'clock from the home where the services will be in English and from the church in Hanson township at 2:30. The Revs. Burmester and Senne will have charge of the services.

Interment will be made in the Lutheran cemetery in Hanson township.
