Herman F. Kuehnert

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon, at the St. John's Lutheran church for Herman F. Kuehnert, who passed away February 22, 1955, in the Veterans' hospital at Wood, Wis. The Rev. R. M. Grundmeier officiated. Burial was in Groton cemetery under military rites.
