Herman A. Kuhfeld, 85, longtime Warner area farmer, died Thursday evening at St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen.

Services were held at 2 p. m., Monday, Feb. 6 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Warner. Burial was in the Warner cemetery.

Mr. Kuhfeld was born May 23, 1881, at Oldshtadt, Germany and came to the United States with his parents six years later. They settled in the Warner area, where he has farmed and lived since. He married Ella Kempf at Aberdeen on May 27, 1915.

He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church.

Survivors include his widow; three sons, Ervin, Edward and Melvin, all of Aberdeen; four daughters, Mrs. Clarence (Delores) Georgens, Groton; Mrs. Arnold (Verna) Schock, Salem; and Mrs. Raymond (Hazel) Dahme and Mrs. Dale (Elvera) Penfield, both of Aberdeen; one sister, Mrs. Martha Fuhrman, Aberdeen; 22 grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
