Mrs. Ida Kuntz

Mrs. Ida C. Kuntz, 89, widow of the late John F. Kuntz, and former residents of Groton, died suddenly at her home in Aberdeen, Monday morning.

Mrs. Kuntz was born on December 25, 1860, at Clyman, Wis., where she grew to womanhood. In January, 1891, she was married to John F. Kuntz at Groton. The young couple started housekeeping here, where Mr. Kuntz operated a bakery. In 1901 they moved to a farm northeast of Groton. Mr. Kuntz passed away in 1919, and Mrs. Kuntz remained on the farm until 1930, when she went to make her home with a son, George Kuntz, on his farm southwest of Aberdeen. Two years ago they moved to Aberdeen.

Survivors are four sons, George and Carl Kuntz, Aberdeen; William Kuntz, Los Angeles, Calif., and Henry Kuntz, Eureka, Calif.; two daughters, Mrs. Emelie Vinton, Groton, and Mrs. Amanda Van Guilder, Minneapolis, Minn.; a brother, Theodore Lieske, Loyal, Wis. Twelve grandchildren and seven great grandchildren also survive.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 o'clock, Friday afternoon at the Huebl Chapel in Aberdeen. Burial in Groton cemetery.
