Zenna Yost Lamb

Services for Mrs. William Zenna Yost Lamb, 89, were held at the Community Church in Pierpont. She died Jan. 30 at the Eastern Star Home in Redfield.

The Rev. Simon TerLouw officiated and burial was in the Pierpont Cemetery under the direction of the Ackerson Funeral Home.

Mrs. Lamb was born Dec. 1, 1882, on a farm in Indiana near Iroquois, Ill. The family later moved to Brook, Ind., where she completed her education and taught school for two years before she married Fred Yost in 1901. They remained in Brook until the death of her father-in-law, Allen Yost in 1904. At that time they moved to the Yost farm near Pierpont and lived there until the death of Mr. Yost in 1926. She continued to manage the farm with hired help.

In 1930 she married William Lamb. Later they moved to Groton. Mr. Lamb died in 1966. Mrs. Lamb resided in Groton until 1969 when she became a resident in the Eastern Star Home in Redfield.

She was a member of Meritum O.E.S. No. 144 of Pierpont and the Pierpont Community Church.

She is survived by two sons, Colonel Lowell A. Yost, El Paso, Texas, and Light B. Yost, Sarasota, Fla.; two sisters, Mrs. Clara Sunderland, Brook, Ind., and Mrs. Opal LeMasters, Yakima, Wash.; two brothers, O.B. Light, Pierpont, and Vernon Light, Silver City; four grandchildren, Gale Yost, Aberdeen, Donn Yost of Pittsburg, Calif., Mrs. Joy Farrow, Dallas, Texas, and Mrs. Sharon Noren, St. Louis, Mo., and eight great-grandchildren.
