Funeral services for Lars A. Larsen, 85, of DeSmet and formerly of Groton, were held at 10:30 a.m., Tuesday, March 29, at the American Lutheran Church in DeSmet.

Committal services were held at 2:30 p.m. the same day at the Groton Union Cemetery.

Mr. Larsen died Saturday at the DeSmet Memorial Hospital.

Lars Larsen was born May 13, 1891, in Norway. He came to the United States in 1909 and settled in Groton. He married Gertrude Morse at Groton on June 15, 1918. He served in World War I.

He farmed in Groton until 1941 when he moved to DeSmet where he worked until his retirement in 1958. Mrs. Larsen died in 1958. For the past three years he has lived at a nursing home in DeSmet.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Otto (Hazel) Sckerl of DeSmet and Mrs. Donald (Margaret) Clocksene of Groton; and two brothers, three sisters, three grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
