

OBITUARY

Ada Larson, daughter of Fred Larson of Columbia, passed away at Custer, S. D., on Sunday morning at the age of 20 years. She was born on January 2, 1905, on the home farm one and one-half miles south and one mile east of Columbia, where she grew to young womanhood.

She attended the public schools in Columbia and then the Northern Normal at Aberdeen, graduating from the latter in 1923. She taught school at Timber Lake in 1923, and at Glenn Cross, S. D., in 1924. The deceased was taken ill one year ago this Christmas, later going to Hot Springs, S. D. and Custer, S. D., in the hope of improving her condition.
