Funeral services were held in the Methodist Church in Callender, Iowa, on June 25, for Andrew Larson, Sr., a long-time resident of North Andover township in Day County. Reverends Hawf and Brown officiated. Burial was in Callender cemetery.

Mr. Larson was engaged in farming until the fall of 1946, at which time he had an auction sale and retired. He made his home with his three older children since that time. He suffered from a heart condition and other ailments. On June 3 he had a stroke from which he never recovered passing away at the Holy Family Hospital in Estherville, Iowa, on June 22.

The departed was born of Danish immigrant parents at Racine, Wis., on Aug. 17, 1871. In 1882 he parents, Peter and Martha Larson moved with their family to a farm near Callender, Iowa, where his parents passed away.

In 1903 Andrew Larson and Tena Atteson were married in Des Moines and in 1905, moved to a farm near Andover. On July 28 his wife passed away, leaving him with three small children. In February 1915, he and Christine Rasmussen of Irwin, S.D., were married at Britton.
