Mother of Groton Man Passes at Warner, Sunday

Mrs. Christine Larson, Brown county pioneer, and mother of Lloyd J. Larson of Groton, passed away Sunday evening at the home of her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. H. C. Trego, at Warner. Mrs. Larson was 81 years of age.

The deceased was born in Goodhue county, Minn., and came to South Dakota with her brother, John Mark, homesteading at Rondell in 1883. On Dec. 26, 1889, she was married to Peter Larson, and they resided on a farm until 1918, when they moved to Aberdeen. Mrs. Larson was a member of the Bethlehem Lutheran church of Aberdeen and an honorary member of the Ladies' Aid and a member of the Degree of Honor lodge.

Left to survive the deceased are three children, Lloyd J., of Groton; Mrs. H. A. Belt of Warren, Wis., and Mrs. Trego of Warner; 18 grandchildren and three great grandchildren. Her husband, a son and a daughter died previously.

Funeral services will be held for Mrs. Larson Thursday at the Bethlehem Lutheran church in Aberdeen, and burial will be in the Riverside cemetery.
