Dennis D. Larson, 68, Andover, died Monday, Feb. 11, at his residence after a five-year battle with cancer. His funeral was held Friday, Feb. 15, at St. John's Lutheran Church, Groton, with the Rev. Craig Grams officiating. Burial followed in the Groton Union Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton. Military rites were conducted by the Groton American Legion Post #39.

Dennis D. Larson was born on November 3, 1943, to Andrew and Bernice (Nehls) Larson in Aberdeen. He attended school in Groton and graduated in 1961. Dennis enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps and served until 1966. Following his discharge, he returned home. On October 14, 1968, he married Ruby Richardson in Andover. Dennis farmed near Andover until the time of his death.

Dennis was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church and the Groton American Legion Post #39. He enjoyed outdoor activities including hunting, fishing and farming. He also enjoyed playing cards, attending Bible Study and spending time with his family.
