She earned a teaching certificate at Northern Normal at Aberdeen and taught school in the Barnard and Columbia areas. She married Lloyd A. Larson December 7, 1922, at Aberdeen and they lived on a farm near Ordway. In 1928 they moved to farm south of Columbia where she was residing at the time of her death.

She was a member of the BLCW, the Aurland Lutheran Ladies Aid and the American Legion Auxiliary of Columbia.
