## Myrtis Larson

Funeral services for Myrtis J. Larson, 68, of 321 9th Ave. S.W., were held at 2 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 12, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, 215 4th Ave. S.E., with the Rev. Stephen Knudsen officiating. Burial was at Sunset Memorial Gardens.

Mrs. Larson died at St. Luke's Hospital, Wednesday, Oct. 9, 1985.
