Henry E. Lehman, 86, 504 North Main, Groton, died at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center March 30. The funeral was held at St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton Friday, April 3. The Reverend John Werner officiated. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.

A prayer service was held at the Paetznick Funeral Chapel in Groton Thursday.

Henry E. Lehman was born September 5 1905 at James to Emil and Ella (Weihrauch) Lehman. He was baptized October 1, 1905 and confirmed April 13, 1919 into the Lutheran faith at James. He attended school in Groton and Henry townships. He married Dorothy Erdmann September 23, 1939 in Groton. They made their home on the Lehman homestead in Henry Township near James until June of 1969 when they moved to Groton. He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton and served the church as an elder and as church secretary for many years. He served on the Henry Township board and on the Henry Township school board for many years. He was a director of the Ferney Farmers Elevator board for 30 years. He was a member of the Groton Senior Citizens.
