The funeral for Kathy A. Leidholdt, 33, Groton was held Friday, May 29 at St. John's Catholic Church in Groton with Pastor John Garvey officiating. Burial was at Groton Union Cemetery, St. John's Section. Mrs. Leidholdt died on Tuesday, May 26 at Dakota Midland Hospital.

Kathleen Ann Hauck was born at Ft. Bragg, N.C. on December 1, 1953 to Donald and Rosemary Kaiser Hauck. When she was a child the family moved to Rapid City, where she started school. In 1959 they moved to Gettysburg, in 1968 they moved to Sioux Falls and in 1969 they moved to Watertown. She graduated from Watertown High School with the Class of 1972. She then joined the South Dakota National Guard in Watertown and served in the 1742nd Transportation Company. She was employed at Mid Tex and Jenkins Nursing Home in Watertown. On June 22, 1979 she was married to Robert Leidholdt at Watertown. They made their first home at Bowdle and in 1980 the family moved to Aberdeen where she worked for Control Data. In June 1986 the family moved to Groton and she con-

tinued to work for Control Data until her health failed as the result of cancer.

She was a member of St. John's Catholic Church of Groton and the Abate Motorcycle Organization of Aberdeen.

Survivors include her husband, Robert Leidholdt, Groton, one son Matthew M. Leidholdt at home, two daughters, Mary Beth Leidholdt and Leah Angela Leidholdt, both at home, her parents, Donald H. and Rosemary C. Hauck, Watertown, four brothers, Joseph Hauck, Summit, Steven Hauck, Donald H. Hauck, Jr. and Charles Hauck, all of Watertown, and her paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Harry A. Hauck, Tolstoy. She was preceded in death by her maternal grandparents.
