Arthur Lenling

Services for Art G. Lenling, 82, retired Glencross area rancher, were held at 2 p.m. Friday, Jan. 19, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Timber Lake. He died Monday, Jan. 15, at the Good Samaritan Nursing Home in Selby.

The Rev. Thomas Schmidt officiated and burial was in the Timber Lake Cemetery.

Mr. Lenling was born February 5, 1890, at Ferney, and married Emma Jensen in 1909 near Ferney. The couple moved to the Timber Lake area in 1918. Mrs. Lenling died in 1927. Mr. Lenling ranched east of Glencross until 1956 when he retired and moved to Timber Lake where he lived until 1965. For the past four years he had been a resident of the Good Samaritan Home.

Survivors include four daughters, Amanda Thomas and Hazel Saupe, both of Timber Lake, Mrs. Louis (Carolyn) Merkel of Glencross and Mrs. W. O. (Adeline) Rorvig of McLaughlin; eight grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.
