HENRY LENLING

After a struggle with ill health extending over a period of six years, Henry Lenling passed away at his home in Groton early Sunday morning. Funeral services were held at the home on Wednesday, and the body was taken to the Hanson cemetery for burial.

He was a native of Ashford, Wis., and was forty-five years of age. Came to this locality as a young man, and in 1891 married Miss Elizabeth Breitzkreutz. A widow, two children and a number of brothers and sisters survive him.

Mr. Lenling was long a prominent citizen of Hanson. Owing to failing health he left the farm two or three years ago, and helped establish the Groton Cement and Tile Co. Last fall he sought health in Colorado and later at Hot Springs, Ark., returning more feeble in health than when he left home. Untiring efforts were made for his care and cure, but all with no permanent benefit.

He was a member of the Lutheran Church in Hanson for 22 years, acting as one of the church wardens for a number of years. For several successive terms he was chosen as assessor of Hanson township.

Funeral services were conducted by Rev. Zimmerman. In their great bereavement the family has the sympathy of all.
