Funeral services for Waldemar Lenling, 77, Groton, were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 22 at St. John's Lutheran Church, Groton, with the Rev. Dan Elkins officiating.

Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens at Aberdeen.

Mr. Lenling died Friday, Oct. 18, 1985 at Dakota Midland Hospital in Aberdeen.
