## Mrs. Caroline Lewis Succumbs on Monday

Mrs. Caroline Lewis, widow of the late Nels Lewis, died in Aberdeen, Monday, after a brief serious illness. She had lived in the Groton community since 1907 when she came here from Hadley, Minn., with her family and removed to Aberdeen to make her home with a daughter after the death of her husband several years ago.

She was a native of Winona, Minn., born April 20, 1865, and she was married to Nels Lewis on November 16, 1897. Four children were born to the union, two of whom preceded their mother in death. Surviving are a son, Theodore H. Lewis, Detroit, Mich., and a daughter, Mrs. Richard Hansen of Aberdeen. A brother, J. H. Jacobson, Long Beach, Calif., and seven grandchildren also survive.

Mrs. Lewis was a member of the First English Lutheran church of Groton and the funeral was held Wednesday afternoon with the Rev. H. A. Oerke, pastor, officiating. Interment was in the Groton Union cemetery.

Many former neighbors of Mrs. Lewis here mourn her as a fine friend, quiet and unassuming, but steadfast in principles and a staunch champion of all that is good and true.
