Services for Carl C. Liebel, 80, retired Groton area farmer, were held Wednesday, March 10, at 2 p.m. in the First Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Robert Carey officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery with military rites conducted by Harold Feser Post No. 262, Claremont.

Mr. Liebel died Sunday morning, March 7, at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen.
