## Miss Emma Lindesmith Dies of Complications

Miss Emma Lindesmith, an esteemed lady of this city, passed away last Friday afternoon at five o'clock from the effects of a series of ailments. She had not been in the best of health for some time.

The funeral was held from the home Monday afternoon and burial was made in Groton cemetery. The obsequies were conducted by Rev. C. B. Cedar.

Miss Lindesmith was born in Jefferson county, Ohio, Feb. 12, 1856, and came to Groton in 1910, settling in the house where she passed away. For a number of years she was one of the leading dress-makers of the city and had a large clientele among the ladies of this vicinity.

She was never married and leaves to mourn her loss two sisters and a nephew. The sisters are Miss Margaret of Groton, and Mrs. Diedrich, of Canton, Ohio. For the last several years of her life she lived quietly at home. Her brother, T. W. Lindesmith, died a few years ago at an advanced age and several years ago her mother passed way at or near the century mark.
