## Margaret Lindesmith

Funeral services for Miss Margaret Lindesmith, who passed away Friday afternoon, at Peabody hospital in Webster, were held Monday afternoon, Sept. 20, 1954, at 2:30 p. m., at the Paetznick Funeral Home in Groton. The Rev. James A. Rice of the Presbyterian church was officiant. Miss Lindesmith had been hospitalized since May 3rd.

Mesdames Amos Doeringsfeld and Otho Rix, with Mrs. Ben Anderson at the piano sang several old hymns. Pallbearers were Geo. Riggs, Ewald Kuehnert, Joe Jost, Ronald Hubbard, Earl A. Mueller and Vance E. Miller. Interment was in the family lot in Groton cemetery.

Margaret Lindesmith was the daughter of Isaac and Martha Lindesmith of Salineville, Ohio, where she was born March 18, 1870. She was the last member of the Lindesmith family, all her brothers and sisters, as well as her parents having preceded her in death; but she leaves several nieces and nephews who reside in Ohio and Florida, besides Lyman Amsden and his wife, Margaret, of Groton.

Miss Lindesmith received her formal education in Ohio, and early entered the field of religious education as secretary and teacher. She had been associated principally with Hull House and Olivet Institute of Chicago. She was a member of Olivet Presbyterian church. She came to Groton in about 1930 and was a member of P. W. O. and Current Event Club.
