Mrs. Henry Locken Passes Away at Aberdeen, Monday

Mrs. Henry A. Locken, 58, who lived near Bath, died Monday at the Aberdeen hospital. Funeral services were held in the Scandinavia Lutheran church at 2:30 p. m., Wednesday, preceded by a short service at the Johnson Funeral home at Aberdeen. The Rev. H. O. Scobey officiated.

Mrs. Locken was born in Gem township on March 6, 1890, and was married to Henry Locken, also of Gem township on Feb. 18, 1913. Mr. Locken preceded her in death on April 23, 1942. Mrs. Locken was a member of the Scandinavia Lutheran church and the Scandinavia Ladies' Aid.
