## Albert Lorenz

Services for Albert Phillip Lorenz, 82, were held at 2 p.m., Saturday, Jan. 16, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton with the Rev. Monte Gusewelle officiating. Burial was in the Union Cemetery in Groton.

Mr. Lorenz died at his home Wednesday, Jan. 13.
