

## Harvey Arnold 'Foxy' Lowary

The funeral for Harvey Arnold "Foxy" Lowary, 75, of Lake Andes and formerly of Aberdeen, was Saturday at Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton. The Rev. Emil Eberhart officiated. Burial followed in Groton Union Cemetery.
