Mrs. Mary Ludwigson Dies at Home of Son

Mrs. Mary Ludwigson, about 84 years of age, died at the home of her son, Nels Lewis, northesat of Groton, Sunday. She had not been in good health for some time.

Mrs. Ludwigson was born in Norway, December 6, 1849, and after her marriage came to America with her husband settling near Iona, Minn., in 1880. They came to Day county in 1902 and settled on a farm, her husband dying in 1911. For the past 22 years she has made her home with her son, Nels, with the exception of several winters spent in California.

She was the mother of ten children, four of whom preceded her in death. Those surviving are: Louie Ludwigson, of Los Angeles; Nels Lewis of Groton; Mrs. Robert Stafford, of Louisville, Neb.; Mrs. Dina Ostemann, of Aberdeen; Mrs. Nellie Popen, of Powell, Wyo.; Fred Ludwigson of Power, Mont.

The funeral was conducted Wednesday afternoon at 1:30 from the First English Lutheran church, by Rev. Melford S. Knutson, and the remains were laid to rest in Groton cemetery.
