DEATH OF MRS. MACE

1 Mrs. Levi Mace, living six Miles east
7 of Groton, died at St. Luke's hospital,
7 Aberdeen on Thursday last, and the
5 funeral service occurred from the M. E.
1 church at Andover on Sunday, Rev.
t Millett of Pierpont preaching the ser-
e mon.

3 The lady had been ill for several
months, and underwent a surgical opera-
1 tion at the hospital some time ago,
recovered sufficiently to return home,
had to return for further treatment,
which resulted fatally.

Deceased was twenty-eight years old,
and became the wife of Levi Mace in
March, 1902. She was a native of Canada
and had been a member of the Baptist
church for several years.

She was a sister of Mrs. Emil Willits
of Groton, and the surviving relatives
have the consolation of knowing that
death relieved the departed of a degree
of suffering much greater than that
which usually falls to the lot of woman-
kind.
