Elliott G Mallett, 98, Groton, died at Colonial Manor, Groton, Tuesday, April 20. The funeral was held at the First Presbyterian Church, Groton, Tuesday, April 22, 1993, with Rev. Richard Geiger officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.

Elliott Mallett was born December 28, 1894 at Andover, to Anthony and Mary Elizabeth (Cook) Mallett. He grew up in the Andover area and attended rural schools and Andover School. He graduated from Groton High School. He served in the United States Army during World War I.

He married Christine Weihrauch at Aberdeen, September 18, 1920. They lived on a farm near Groton, until they retired and moved into Groton in 1982. He has been a resident at Colonial Manor, Groton since 1983. He attended the First Presbyterian Church, Groton. He was a member of the Groton American Legion, and the World War I Barracks of Aberdeen, until it was dissolved.

He is survived by one brother, Floyd Mallett, Chicago, Ill.; one sister, Mrs. Ada Quincer, Paradise Calif.; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, wife, four brothers and one sister. Casketbearers were Jon Anderson, Tom Mahan, Roger Rix, Clayton Sternhagen, Dan Thayer, and Tom Woods.
