Stuart Manning

Funeral services for Stuart Righter Manning, 62, of 1856 Eisenhower Circle, Aberdeen were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Feb. 3, at the First Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Willard Elton, Aberdeen area minister, officiating.

Burial was in the Sunset Memorial Gardens with Charles A. Howard Jr. in charge of Masonic committal services.

Mr. Manning died Friday, Jan. 30 at St. Mary's Hospital in Rochester, Minn., after undergoing heart surgery.

Mr. Manning was born March 12, 1913, near Randolph. He later moved with his family to the Tacoma Park area and Plana area. He married Lusena Alberts on April 9, 1940 at Webster. They lived in Aberdeen after their marriage.

He was the service manager for the former E.R. Judy Motor Co. In 1959 he joined Julius Kirschenmann in purchasing the company which they renamed Aberdeen Motors Co. He retired from that company in 1968. In 1969 he sold his interest in Aberdeen Motors and affiliated with the Loel Lust Co., until 1975 when he became recorder of the Aberdeen Yelduz Shrine.
