Mrs. John McKiver, of Hanson, who was visiting at the home of her daughter, Mrs. W. R. Preston, was taken with an attack of bronchitis, and died about nine o'clock Monday morning, after very brief illness.

Deceased was a native of Scotland, born seventy-five years ago. Her maiden name was Mary Thompson. In 1848 she became the wife of John McKiver. On coming to America they settled in Canada, where they lived many years, removing to their Dakota home in 1883. She is survived by her husband, five sons and four daughters—Angus, Thomas and William, Mrs. Preston, Mrs. W. E. Clark, Mrs. Frank Rapp and Mrs. Hoag, residing in this locality; John McKiver of Marshall, Mich., and David McKiver of Minneapolis.

Funeral services were held at the Presbyterian Church on Wednesday afternoon, and a very large audience which assembled to pay their last respects, listened to an eloquent sermon by Rev. J. S. Butt.

Mr. and Mrs. McKiver celebrated their golden anniversary seven years ago. The lady was highly esteemed by a large circle of friends for her noble, lovable character.
