Services for Henry W. Meyer, 85, were held Friday, Oct. 18, at the Methodist Church in Conde, with the Rev. James Vos officiating. Burial was in the Conde Cemetery under the direction of the Ackerson Funeral Home.

Henry W. Meyer, eldest son of Henry W. and Jean B. Meyer was born March 4, 1883 at Wellington, Ill. In 1885, he came with his parents to the Dakota Territory where they homesteaded northeast of Crandall. In 1893, the family moved into the Conde area where Mr. Meyer resided until his death.

He was united in marriage to Bessie M. Taylor at Aberdeen, on Feb. 18, 1914. They established their home on a farm northeast of Conde where they lived until 1938 when due to ill health, they moved into Conde. Mrs. Meyer died in 1960. Then he lived at the home of Mrs. Anna White in Conde. He passed away on Oct. 15, at the Day County Hospital at Webster after a two months illness.

Survivors include a son, Henry R. of Conde and a daughter, Mrs. Harold (Mary) Engberg, LaCrescenta, Calif. Two sisters, Mrs. Talmer Combs, Conde, and Mrs. George Bain, Elkton, and five grandchildren.
