Services for Arthur H. (Bud) Mielke Sr., 67, of 1212 North State Street, Aberdeen, were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 2, at Our Savior Lutheran Church. The Rev. Raymond L. Pomplun officiated and burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens.

Mr. Mielke died unexpectedly Friday night.

Arthur Henry Mielke was born September 24, 1905, on a farm near Ferney to George and Lena Mielke where he grew to manhood. He married Virginia Harry at Groton on July 2, 1926. They moved to Detroit where he was employed in the automobile industry.

Three years later they returned to Ferney where Mr. Mielke worked for the Ferney Farmers Elevator. In 1944 they moved to Aberdeen where he was employed by several firms. He had worked for the past 22 years for Safeguard Industries and its predecessor, Hub City Iron. He was head inspector at the time of his death.
