George E. Miller, 87, Groton, died May 12, 1997 at Colonial Manor in Groton. The funeral was held May 17 at the Aberdeen Wesleyan Church with the Rev. Rod Griffin officiating. Burial was at Riverside Memorial Park, Aberdeen, under the direction of Miller-Huebl Funeral Home, Aberdeen.

They farmed at Onaka for a short time and then moved to Putney Township near Groton, where they farmed until their retirement in 1973. They continued to live on the farm. She died on October 3, 1990. He continued to reside at his home at rural

Groton until the time of his death. He was a member of the Aberdeen Wesleyan Church. He enjoyed hunting, trapping, woodworking and being with his grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Survivors include two daughters, Mildred (Donald) Steward, Chelsea, S.D.; and Arlis (Douglas) Harms, Groton; five grandchildren and fourteen great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, two great grandchildren, one brother and one sister.
