Richard Miller

Services for Richard (Richie) Miller, 82, retired rural mail carrier, were held Monday afternoon, Nov. 17, at 2 p.m. at the United Methodist Church in Conde with the Rev. James Persons officiating. Burial was in the Conde Cemetery with military and Masonic graveside rites.

Mr. Miller died Saturday, Nov. 15, at St. John's Hospital in Huron.

Music was provided by the church quartet, accompanied by Mrs. Melvin Rossow, organist.

Casket bearers were Clair Cowan, Robert Rossow, Verdon; Marvin Hanson, Huron; Robert Kimmel, Wilmot; Lloyd Neumann, Aberdeen; and Coleman Wagner, Clark.

Mr. Miller was born March 31, 1893, in Iron Mountain, Mich. He moved to a farm near Crandall at age 11. He married Ella Kimmel September 3, 1919, at Webster and they established their home on a farm near Verdon. In 1926 he became employed as a mail carrier and remained in that post for 36 years. He retired in 1961 and they moved to Conde. For the past six years he had been residing in a nursing home in Huron. He was a member of Post No. 148 of the American Legion at Conde; the Conde Masonic Lodge, The Yelduz Shrine of Aberdeen, Scottish Rite of Aberdeen and the Rural Mail Carriers Association.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Lyle (Alleyn) Potter of Beaverton, Ore., and Mrs. John (Marilyn) Kent of Sparta, N.J.; and five grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife in 1969 and a half-brother.
