Mrs. Rose Miller, 87, Stratford, died Thursday, Dec. 3, at St. Luke's Hospital.

Services were held at 2 p.m. Monday, Dec. 7, at the First Presbyterian Church in Stratford with the Rev. Robert Carey officiating. Burial was in the West Woodell Cemetery.
