Funeral for Mrs. Hans Moe Held on Friday

Mrs. Hans Moe, 67, of Gem township, died of a heart attack Tuesday morning, Oct. 21, at the Aberdeen hospital.

Mrs. Moe was born at Valdres, Norway, on March 14, 1880. She was married to Hans Moe at Valdres on March 5, 1905. They came to the United States in 1905, settling on a farm in Gem township, where they had resided since.

Mrs. Moe was a member of the Scandinavian Lutheran church of Gem township and of the Ladies' Aid.
