Frank H. Moldenhauer passed away on May 31, at the Redfield Community Hospital at Redfield.

Funeral services were held Saturday, June 3rd, at 2:00 p. m., at St. John Lutheran Church here with the Rev. Gordon Buchholz officiating. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Aberdeen.
