Mrs. Morehouse

Mrs. Lowell (Alice) Morehouse, 31, rural Andover, was killed Saturday in an accident at the Lloyd Morehouse farm east of Andover.

Authorities said Mrs. Morehouse was standing behind a truck which rolled backwards and pinned her between the back of the truck and a log grinder.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Dec. 16 at 2 p.m. at the Holy Trinity Methodist Church in Bristol. The Rev. Donald Burkhalter officiated and burial was in the Bristol City Cemetery.

Mrs. Morehouse was born Sept. 6, 1939, in Webster, and married Lloyd Morehouse Sept. 22, 1962 in Andover.

Survivors include her husband, one daughter, Corinne, 7, at home; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Farnen, Redfield; five brothers, Clayton Farnen, Groton; Erroll Farnen, stationed with the U.S. Air Force in Germany; Calvin Farnen, stationed at Traverse Air Force Base, David, with the National Guard at Fort Campbell, Ky.; and three at home, two sisters, Mrs. Margaret (McIntosh) Holler, and Mrs. Margaret (Ardith) Schaunaman, both of Andover, and her grandfather, Clayton Farnen, Costa Mesa, Calif.
