Funeral services for Earl A. Mueller, 73, Groton businessman were conducted at the Presbyterian Church at 2 p. m., Monday, Sept. 23, with the Rev. Robert Carey officiating. Burial was in the Groton cemetery. Paetznick Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Mueller, owner of an insurance firm in Groton, died Thursday night at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen.

He was born May 10, 1890 at Langford and was married to Florence Sliter at Groton, May 28, 1924.

He was a member and treasurer of the Presbyterian Church at Groton; a member of the American Legion; a charter member of Veterans of World War One; member of Kiwanis; of the Masonic Blue Lodge, Commandery and Yelduz Temple of the Shrine, and Eastern Star.

During the 1920's he was elected to the State House of Representatives for two terms; he had served 30 years as city auditor and was sexton of the cemetery.

He leaves his wife, Florence; and one sister, Mrs. Hazelle Dobson, Eugene, Ore.
