

## Dora Nehls <sup>7/16/84</sup>

Mrs. Dora Nehls, 90, Groton, died Friday, May 4, at Colonial Manor, Groton.

Her funeral was held Tuesday at 2 p.m., in St. John's Lutheran Church, Groton, with the Rev. Dan Elkins officiating. Burial was in Groton Union Cemetery. Paetznick-Garness Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
