## Erich Neumann

Funeral services for Erich Neumann, 76, Groton, were held Saturday afternoon at St. John's Lutheran Church with the Rev. Terry Cashmer officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery. The Paetznick - Garness Funeral Chapel was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Neumann died Wednesday evening, March 9, at his home here in Groton of an apparent heart attack.

Casketbearers were Eugene Neuman, Duane Neumann, Robert Kimmel, Richard Donovan, Lyle Thurston and Alvin Bahr.

Mrs. William Schuelke, organist, accompanied Richard Karnopp, soloist, as he sang "I Am Trusting Thee, Lord Jesus" and "How Great Thou Art."

Mr. Neumann was born May 24, 1900, at Pinconning, Mich. He came to the Groton area in 1917. He married Mabel Kimmel September 16, 1934, at Groton. She died in 1957, and he later married Mary Stange Paeth on September 15, 1958, at Groton. He worked as a carpenter, and also operated a hardware store and shoe repair shop in Groton.

Survivors include his widow; one son, Lloyd of Aberdeen; one daughter, Miss Clarice Neumann of Aberdeen; two brothers, Edwin of Pinconning, Mich., and George of Shelby, Mich.; and three grandsons.

He was preceded in death by his first wife; three brothers and two sisters.
