## Lloyd Neumann

The funeral services for Lloyd E. Neumann, 50, Groton, were held at 10 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 11, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton with the Revs. Dan Elkins and Ray Giese officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel of Groton.

He died Monday, Sept. 9, 1985, at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen.
