## Mrs. Erich Neumann

Funeral services were held for Mrs. Erich Neumann, Wednesday, at 2:00 p. m., at St. John's Lutheran church, with the Rev. R. M. Grundmeier officiating. The church choir, namely Mesdames R. M. Grundmeier, Louis Krueger, Henry Lehman and Elmer Herron sang several selections, accompanied by Mrs. A. J. Schuelke at the organ. Burial was in the Groton cemetery.
