Mrs. Anna Nierman, 90, pioneer, died in Wenatchee, Wash., December 28, 1971.

Born Anna Amelia Jorgenson, May 13, 1881, in Oslo, Norway, she came with her parents to South Dakota in 1890 where she grew to womanhood on a farm in the Scatterwood Lake vicinity. After homesteading in Edmunds County, she married William F. Nierman June 29, 1908, in Valley City, N.D. In 1911 they filed on a homestead near Big Sandy, Mont., returning to S.D. in 1913. They resided in the Mansfield area until 1934 when they moved to Washington state.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Olive Lane, Wenatchee, Wash.; three sons, Wallace R., Ferney, Fred W., Cashmere, Wash., and Ray W., Anacortes, Wash.; 13 grandchildren; 24 great-grandchildren; and three great-great-grandchildren.

Burial was in Cashmere, Wash.
