## **HENRY ODLAND PASSES AWAY**

**CLAREMONT MAN EXPIRES FROM  
HEART COMPLICATIONS;  
FUNERAL MONDAY**

Henry Odland, who has been making his home at Claremont for the past three years, and the father of Vic. Odland of this city, passed away last Friday afternoon at 2:30, from heart complications. He was born in Clay county, South Dakota, September 6, 1865, and was a resident of that county for 70 years.

Mr. Odland was married in 1888 to Miss Lydia Larson, who passed away in 1917. Eleven children were born to this union, ten of whom are living. They are Mrs. Ella McCrary of Hurley, S.
