Carl August Olson

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Feb. 6th, at 2:00 p. m., in the Augustana Lutheran church near Claremont for Gust. Olson of Groton. The Rev. C. Seburg of Webster officiated. Burial was in the Augustana Lutheran cemetery.

Carl August Olson was born on November 30, 1880, in Gemshoy, Blikings, Sweden and passed away at the Peabody hospital in Webster on February 2, 1951, at the age of 70 years, two months and two days, following a long illness.

He came to America April 24, 1905, settling in Minneapolis, Minn., remaining there until the year of 1918, when he came to the Groton vicinity. He was married to Emma Swenson, June 10, 1919, who preceded him in death three years ago. They resided on a farm northeast of Groton until 1945, after which they moved to Groton where Mr. Olson was employed at the Bowles & Sour garage until the time of his illness.

He was a member of Augustana Lutheran church of Claremont for many years, being confirmed in Sweden.

Surviving is a brother in Sweden; three nieces and one nephew, Mrs. Hulda Haywood, Mrs. George Heinz, Walter Swanson of Langford and Mrs. Harry Heinz of Groton.
