## Marshall Osman

Marshall Osman, 78, former Groton and Aberdeen resident, died Monday, March 3, at a Huron nursing home.

Services were Wednesday, March 5, at the American Lutheran Church in Huron with the Rev. Merlyn Huke officiating.

Burial was in Riverside Cemetery, Huron.

Marshall S. Osman was born on January 30, 1902, at Walnut Grove, Minn. As a young child he moved with his family to Groton where he attended school and grew up. He moved to Aberdeen and worked for Spaulding Auto for 25 years. He married Sena Vikse June 15, 1924, at Aberdeen. In 1945 they moved to Huron where he purchased the Buick agency which he operated until his death. He and his wife had been residing at 821 Nebraska S.W. in Huron.

He was a member of the Aberdeen Masonic Lodge No. 38, the Consistory, York Rite, Yelduz Shrine and James Valley Shrine Club. He was a past president of Sertoma, a past director of the S.D. Auto Dealers Association and was a member of the Huron Elks Lodge No. 444 and the United Commercial Travelers.
