Maurice H. Osman

Maurice H. Osman, 72, of Hot Springs, and formerly of Groton, died December 3, 1987 at Rapid City Regional Hospital following surgery. Memorial services were held December 7th at Bethesda Lutheran Church in Hot Springs with the Rev. Ed Bade officiating.

Maurice was born May 29, 1915 to Joseph and Ella (Brendemuehl) Osman at Groton. He graduated from Groton High School in 1932.

In 1934, he joined the Civilian Conservation Corps and served until 1937. He then worked two years in Hot Springs and one year at the Groton Hatchery.

He married Ruth I. Huebner in Hot Springs in 1940. They moved to Culver City, Calif., where he was employed by Douglas Aircraft factory.

In 1942 they returned to Hot Springs where he was employed at

the Black Hills Ordinance Depot of Igloo. He purchased Steven Studio at Hot Springs in 1946 and remained in the photography business until he retired in 1985.

He was a member of Bethesda Lutheran Church and served in many church offices as well as a member of the Lutheran Layman's League.

He was a lifetime member of the National Rifle Association, of the National Association of CCC's, and a 40 year member of the Hot Springs Chamber of Commerce.

He is survived by his wife of Hot Springs; one son, Neal, Oswego, Ill.; one sister, Mrs. Eldon (Irene) Rehfuss, Groton; one granddaughter, Cherie and one grandson, Scott of Oswego.

He was preceded in death by his father in 1962 and his mother in November, 1987.
