## OBITUARY

Darius B. Padellford died at 5:25 p. m., May 19th, at the St. Luke's hospital of Aberdeen after an illness of several months. First he had a leg broken, later he was horned by a cow and while hurt then was stricken with an incurable disease—heart and stomach trouble—and had suffered intense pain all winter. He was taken to the hospital at Rochester and to the best doctors here but medical aid seemed to be of no use. He suffered very little at the end which came very sudden. He was a man well liked and respected wherever he lived and was a hard worker and christian of holiness belief.

Mr. Padellford was 73 years and five months old, born Sept. 11th, 1836 at Greenfield, Saratoga Co., New York. Was married to Ermina M. Lyons 55 years ago—Mar. 27th, 1855. To this union two children were born, Linwood H. Padellford of Nevada, Ia., and Chas. L. Padellford, of Austin, Minn, who died May 6th, 1909.

Mr. Padellford leaves to mourn his loss, his wife, one son, a granddaughter, Mrs. John Wittenberg of Putney, a grand-son of Iowa and four brothers and a sister of Austin, Minn. He moved from New York to Iowa in 1869 and was engaged as contractor and builder while there. March 4th, 1904 they moved onto their farm at Putney where he remained until this year.

Rev. E. S. Brown of Groton conducted the funeral service on Sunday afternoon.
