Services for Mrs. Cyril Paepke, 53, Mansfield were held at 9:30 a. m., Wednesday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Aberdeen with the Rev. James Joyce of Mellette officiating. Burial was in Sacred Heart cemetery. A Rosary was recited at 8 p. m. Tuesday at the Gates Funeral Home.

Mrs. Paepke was born Dec. 20, 1909 in Aberdeen where she grew to womanhood. She attended Sacred Heart School and Central High School. In 1932 she was graduated from Presentation School of Nursing. She worked as a nurse for the late Dr. Thomas Jones of Bowdle. She was married to Joseph Kelsch in 1934 and they made their home in Aberdeen. Mr. Kelsch died in 1954.

In 1958 she was married to Cyril Paepke of Groton and they made their home at Mansfield. For a number of years Mrs. Paepke was a nurse in Aberdeen and worked in the offices of the late Dr. Frank Cooley and later for Drs. J. A. Eckrich and John Rodine.

She was a member of All Saints Catholic Church in Mellette, Altar Society, Aberdeen American Legion Auxilliary, Moose Lodge and the S. D. Ass'n of Nurses.
