DEATH OF HERMAN PAEPKE.

Sudden death called Herman Paepke at his home out near the river at about four o'clock Tuesday afternoon. He had been up at James Station, and returning home was not feeling well. He was lying down in the seat, and Mrs. Paepke came out and unhitched the team. When she returned to the wagon Mr. Paepke was a corpse, heart failure being undoubtedly the immediate cause of death.

Mr. Paepke was one of the early settlers of this locality, coming here in the early eighties. Funeral services occur today, and the body will be laid to rest in the cemetery at Bath.
